Free 3D printing is now available at Bishopstown and Grand Parade libraries.

- You can print 3D models you have
 - downloaded.
 - created yourself.
- You can download models from a number of websites for example www.thingiverse.com , www.myminifactory.com , www.youimage.com , www.ultimaker.com
- You can create your own design, for example, on **Tinkercad** (free 3D design software) www.tinkercad.com
- Designs need to be run through the free to download [CURA software](#) in order to be read by the Ultimaker 2+.
- Save the designs to your SD card, bring it to the library. A member of staff will print them on the 3D printer for you.

There is currently no charge for occasional use of the printer. More regular usage will incur charges.
